



Smart Export Guarantee (SEG) V1.1 Tariff

The SEG Tariff has the following features:

- An annual payment for the electricity exported to the grid
- No fixed end date although Shell Energy reserves the right to vary it or to terminate it on 30 days notice in writing

Becoming a SEG customer

To be eligible for the SEG Tariff: your property must have a SMETS compliant meter with an export register; you must complete a registration form and provide the MCS certificate for the property.
